





## **INFORMATIONS NOGARO**

6-7-8 SEPTEMBER 2024

Track Length: 3,636 km

## Circuit / Paddock / Box access:

Thursday, September 5, 2:00 pm to 8:00 pm Friday, September 6 from 8.00 am to 7.00 pm

Outside these times, access to the circuit will not be possible.

Competitors must vacate their boxes and paddocks by 9:00 p.m. on Sunday at the latest.

Out of respect for spectators, it will not be possible to dismantle structures or recover trailers before 5:30 p.m. on Sunday.

**Competitor reception desk**: HVM Office: 1st floor, Control Tower. Here you can collect your practice sessions, participation certificates, etc... Opening hours: Thursday, from 2:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and Friday, Saturday and Sunday from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Administrative checks: will take place in the paddocks of each grid for Formula Ford Kent, Formula Ford Historic, Superberlines, Lotus, Roadster and Saloons Sars, except for the F3 & FR Classic, Youngtimers GTI Cup, GT Classic, Maxi 1300 Series, Maxi 2L Classic, Racing Over 2L, Protos Classic, Protos Historic and 200km grids, which will take place at the Competitor Welcome Desk.

Briefings: On-site briefings are no longer compulsory (except for the 200km class) and we ask you to take note of the video and written briefings soon to be available online on the HVM website here. However, on-the-spot briefings (by type of start) are available for volunteer drivers. Face-to-face briefings take place in the briefing room above stalls 1 and 2, accessed via the blue stairwell.

Technical scrutineering will take place in the competitors' facilities (Paddock or Box) on Friday from 8.30 a.m. until 2 hours before the briefings (except for the F3 & FR Classic grid). Competitors must remain at the disposal of the stewards near their vehicles.

PASS: all persons accessing the site must wear a wristband. Please note that the Nogaro circuit is in charge of creating new passes and accreditations for this event only (drivers' bracelets, team bracelets and car passes). The usual accesses and passes will not work on this circuit.

**Private testing**: sessions are organized on Friday. It is advisable to book sessions in advance to ensure space and to take advantage of the preferential rate. Reservations must be made online by <u>Tuesday, September 3 at 9:00 a.m.</u> on <u>www.hvmracing.fr</u> under "<u>Historic Tour - Nogaro</u>", with secure payment by credit card. Please note that, for safety reasons, private tests are no longer timed.

Stands (7m x 15m): To be booked EXCLUSIVELY online at www.hvmracing.fr in the "Historic Tour -Nogaro" section, (Rental: €595), Deposit: €500.00 + €50 deposit for keys (2 bank cheques only will be



















required), keys will be handed over by the Track Manager at the end of the inventory of fixtures. Thursday from 2pm to 7:30pm and Friday from 8am to 6pm.

**Licenses**: Each driver must hold at least a national competitor/driver license. Foreign drivers holding a national license must present a foreign participation authorization issued by their ASN. It is also possible to take out weekend licenses (titres de participation) by presenting a medical certificate of no contraindication to the practice of motor sport, less than 6 months old, and a copy of the driver's license. The 2024 fees are as follows TPNVHCC: €40 ASA fee + €145 payable to ASA Classic. Entry tickets must be picked up at the competitor reception desk.

**Transponders**: All competitors must be equipped with Chronelec / Tag Heuer Elite transponders or ITS Chrono Cobra 360 transponders, on sale here. Rental will be available from the timekeeper at the event for €60 per meeting (deposit: €300 in cheque or cash).

Trackwalk: Thursday, September 5 from 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm, on foot only (no thermal or motorized equipment).
